FAST is an open, international technical forum with the voluntary participation of wireless service providers, interested vendors, and associations that provide intersystem operations implementing the Advanced Mobile Phone Service (ANSI-41) family of standards, (e.g., EIA/TIA 553, IS-85, IS-136, IS-91).

MISSION
Facilitate the identification and resolution of technical issues to enable the international interoperability of systems using the ANSI-41 family of standards resulting in the steady migration toward seamless service.

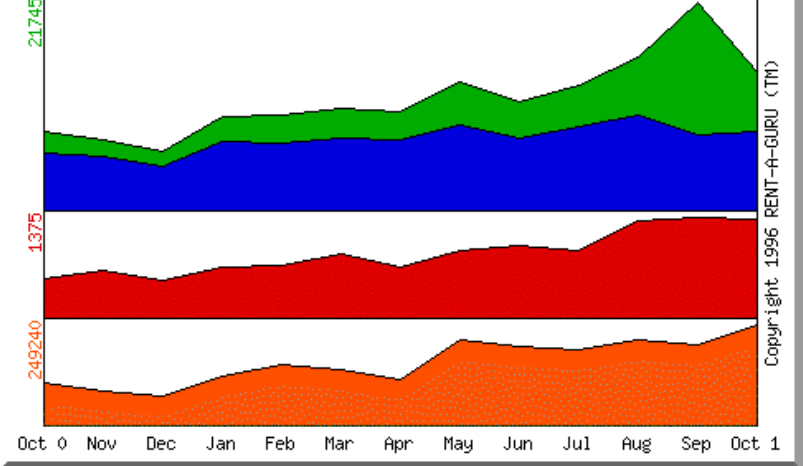
