Project Status

- **Further Discussion at January 2002 T1S1.3 (MTP) Meeting.**
 - There were no new or continuing technical issues with regard to assigning ANSI-41 SS7 Point Codes (within the “006” LNC) outside of the NANP-serving area.
 - The revision of text continues in order to capture the agreement to authorize such assignments.
 - It is anticipated that the revised text will be approved for letter ballot at the 4/02 meeting and approved at the July 02 meeting, assuming no substantive comments.
 - Code application procedures for non-NANP area applicants were agreed (from Telcordia, as the PC Administrator) and will be added to the text.
- **“Conditional” Assignment of PCs**
 - Telcordia, as the PC Administrator has agreed to make “conditional” assignments prior to ballot approval of the revised T1.111.8 (ATIS “understands”).
 - “Conditional” means: “It is understood that currently all SS7 point code assignments to non-North American entities are conditional. The condition is that if the ANSI T1S1 Committee does not formally approve the revised policy, that allows such assignments, by September 2002, the code assignments will be void, the assignee will deactivate and return the codes to the Administrator, and the codes will be subject to reassignment. The undersigned, as point code applicant/assignee, accepts all risks and consequences therein.” (Statement on International Applications)
 - Five “conditional” assignments have already been made (URL: ss7pcadmin.com).
